Choose the right product - and know its limits.

A downloadable guide to the live Product Hub, grouped tutorials, verified destinations, and the complete 28-product public readiness inventory.

Readiness rule

A ZIP that exists is not automatically production-ready. Use the exact status, evidence, next step, and environment-specific checks for each product.

Quick start

- Open <https://journeytoonlinesuccess.com> and start with Tutorials & learning for API Camp, API + LLM, Magnet SDET, and Pytest.
- Open a demo or project page before downloading when one is available.
- Read the readiness label and next release step on every product card.
- Verify the downloaded file against the published SHA-256 value.
- Open the package README and use staging or a disposable environment first.
- Add only your own credentials locally; never send credentials or private exports through support messages.

Readiness vocabulary

Technically verified

The stated local or learning workflow and relevant automated checks pass. It is not a blanket security or compatibility certification.

Configuration required

The package needs real infrastructure, credentials, policy choices, staging tests, or provider authorization.

Limited	Evaluation material, a development sample, documentation gap, or environment-specific release.
Blocked	Do not install, sell, or operate the historical build until the named corrective gates pass.

	The archive is indexed and screened, but no standalone setup guide or package license was found in the release archive.	
	Next: Add installation, environment, test, support, and licensing documentation before broader release.

	The listed HTTPS page returned HTTP 200 on 2026-08-09 and the plugin archive is indexed. Affiliate destinations, disclosures, WordPress compatibility, forms, privacy, and rollback remain environment-specific.	
	Next: Test the exact ZIP on staging and verify every public destination and disclosure before production use.	
05	DomainLaunch Domain Searcher	Downloadable evaluation tool
	The archive, integrity entry, and README are present. Registration and trademark status are deliberately not guaranteed, and no package license was found.	
	Next: Add a license and verify the current registrar workflow before public commercial distribution.	
06	Solo Engine	Connector setup required
	The source package is documented and screened. Publishing adapters, credentials, consent, retry behavior, and destination-specific permissions are not preconfigured.	
	Next: Activate one permitted connector in staging and test preview, approval, delivery, retry, and stop controls.	

07	Focus Redirect	Compatibility evidence incomplete
	Browser and mobile builds are packaged, but the release archive lacks a standalone setup guide and a current cross-environment compatibility matrix.	
	Next: Document installation and test clean install, core redirect behavior, uninstall, rollback, and mobile behavior.	
08	TopicFeed Focus	Extension release evidence incomplete
	The versioned extension archive is indexed and screened, but the release package lacks setup and licensing documentation.	
	Next: Add installation, permissions, browser compatibility, uninstall, rollback, and license documentation.

	The PWA archive and README are present. Production origin, installability, offline behavior, mobile compatibility, and external YouTube behavior remain environment-dependent.	
	Next: Test the final HTTPS origin on supported mobile browsers before promoting installation.	
10	Video Resource Saver	Developer package
	The source package and README are present. Authentication, storage, video-provider rules, access control, deployment, and licensing require completion.	
	Next: Complete a private staging deployment and authorization review before accepting user data.	
11	Nuggets of Wisdom	Private deployment required
	The source and README are present. Supabase, OAuth, storage, recipient consent, access review, delivery scheduling, and recovery must be configured privately.	
	Next: Run the complete private-delivery acceptance path with synthetic recipients and least-privilege storage.

	The public CSV upload, validation, queue review, local persistence, and cleaned export workflow is static and tested. It does not perform authenticated Benable posting.	
	Next: Use the exported queue with the separate secure local runner only after checking current platform rules and authorization.

	The public workflow builder, local persistence, JSON import and export, step editing, and labeled simulation are static and tested. External integrations are not connected.	
	Next: Configure and stage one permitted server-side connector separately before describing any workflow as automated.

	The Python source and README are present. OCR dependencies, input quality, external metadata terms, error handling, and licensing need environment-specific validation.	
	Next: Test a representative image set and document accuracy limits, failure handling, and data-retention behavior.

	The public campaign planner, UTM builder, local schedule, persistence, link copy, and CSV and JSON exports are static and tested. It does not auto-publish.	
	Next: Review each campaign and use a separately authorized connector only after platform, consent, retry, and revocation checks.	
16	Job Skill Planner	Live private-by-default planner
	The public tool analyzes user-provided job text, maps skills, saves locally, and exports a learning plan. It does not claim live job discovery or application submission.	
	Next: Verify the generated priorities against the original posting and never paste confidential applicant or employer data.	
17	HostPapa Promo Hub	WordPress and affiliate review required
	The plugin archive is indexed, but it contains no standalone setup guide. Affiliate links, disclosures, consent, form delivery, compatibility, and rollback require verification.	
	Next: Document and test staging installation, shortcode output, disclosures, lead handling, uninstall, and rollback.

	The historical build is withheld because rendered output and destructive comment-cleanup safeguards have not passed corrective review.

	Licensing and destructive cleanup paths have not passed the paid-product release gate.	
	Next: Replace the licensing protocol and complete payment, refund, backup, recovery, and compatibility evidence.

	High-volume compatibility, backup, rollback, uninstall, recovery, and licensing evidence are incomplete.

	The delivery kit, capacity model, and validation controls pass locally. Public sales remain blocked until identity, policy, tax, payment, refund, form, and measured-delivery evidence are complete.	
	Next: Complete the capacity-capped private-pilot configuration and a settled payment/full-refund test before selling.	

23	Mass Comment Cleaner Launch Bundle	Commercial release blocked
	The bundle remains unavailable because its included plugin and licensing editions failed commercialization checks.	
	Next: Do not distribute or sell the historical archive; release only a rebuilt bundle that passes every edition gate.	
24	HostPapa Promo Kit	Editable campaign material
	The package and README are present. Affiliate destinations, disclosures, factual claims, platform rules, forms, and licensing must be reviewed before publication.	
	Next: Replace placeholders, verify every destination and claim, and run the final disclosure and privacy review.	
25	Resources Hub Traffic Engine	Review-first campaign kit
	The package, campaign dashboard, and README are present. Draft posts are not permission to publish and external channels are not configured.	
	Next: Review each message and destination under current channel rules, then approve and publish manually or through a permitted connector.	
26	Medium AI Articles Kit	Editorial drafts
	The package and README are present. Articles still require current source review, originality review, platform compliance, human editing, and owner-controlled publication.	
	Next: Fact-check and edit each article immediately before publication; do not automate account posting without authorization.	
27	Bulk Uploader Playground Sample	Development sample only
	The small archive is indexed but contains no standalone setup guide or license and is labeled as a Playground sample rather than a production plugin.	
	Next: Add documentation, permission limits, validation, rollback, uninstall, compatibility, and licensing before wider use.	
28	Pytest Tutorial	Tutorial documentation gap
	The tutorial archive is indexed and screened, but no standalone setup guide or package license was found in the release.	
	Next: Add installation, expected results, troubleshooting, and license documentation before broader distribution.	

Verify a download

Use the Product Hub integrity row or release-manifest.json to find the expected SHA-256 value. Then calculate the downloaded file's hash:

```
Get-FileHash .\downloaded-file.zip -Algorithm SHA256
```

A matching hash proves the file matches the indexed release. It does not prove the file is malware-free, compatible with your environment, legally suitable, or safe to operate with production data.

Production acceptance checklist

- Clear ownership and a package license appropriate to the intended use.
- Documented runtime, installation, configuration, permissions, and dependencies.
- Clean installation and core workflow tested in every supported environment.
- Negative, failure, retry, cancellation, uninstall, rollback, backup, and recovery tests where relevant.
- No committed credentials, browser profiles, private databases, personal paths, or authentication state.
- Privacy, consent, retention, deletion, accessibility, support, and incident boundaries appropriate to the product.
- Current third-party terms, API contracts, affiliate disclosures, prices, taxes, and external destinations reviewed.
- Owner review of the exact artifact and deployment commit before release.

Commercial boundary	The Product Hub has no first-party checkout or blanket support contract. Paid release requires a real seller identity, monitored contacts, complete terms and refund rules, tested payment and refund paths, delivery evidence, and validated buyer demand.
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Privacy and security

The hub's narrow measurement system is designed for allowlisted aggregate daily counters without application-level visitor identities. Downloads must not contain credentials, browser profiles, authentication state, private databases, cache directories, dependency directories, or personal workstation paths. Stop if a tool requests access unrelated to its stated function.
